







The purpose of the Proposed Action is to reduce flood risk, enhance ecosystems, and provide greater recreation opportunities within the Trinity River Corridor in Dallas, Texas. Implementation of the Proposed Action is needed to comply with Section 5141 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007.



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, in partnership with the City of Dallas, has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement to analyze the potential comprehensive environmental consequences resulting from the application of proposed Balanced Vision Plan (BVP) Study Flood Risk Management elements, BVP Study Ecosystem Restoration and Recreation features, and Interior Drainage Plan improvements in combination with the impacts associated with the implementation of identified past, present, and reasonably foreseeable projects in and around the Study Area.
