Corps of Engineers announces the Dallas Floodway Extension final Supplement to the Environmental Impact Statement is available for review

FORT WORTH, TX -- Officials of the Fort Worth District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, announced today that the final Supplement No. 1 to the Environmental Impact Statement (FSEIS) for the Dallas Floodway Extension is complete and available for review. The document addresses the cumulative impacts of other similar projects in the DFE geographic area, as mandated by the U.S. District Court Order of Summary Judgment.

The close of the review period is June 9, 2003 which is 30 days after the publication of the notice in the Federal Register. .
