## **Corps of Engineers receives request from City of Georgetown for park and recreation lease at Lake Georgetown**

FORT WORTH, TX -- The Fort Worth District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, has received a request from the City of Georgetown for a park and recreation land lease. The land tract proposed for lease is approximately 21 acres in size and is located downstream of the Lake Georgetown dam. The lease area would be developed by the city for multiple recreational and educational training purposes, including a hike and bike trail.

The public is invited to review the lease proposal and offer any comments to the Corps. The lease request is available for review at the Lake Georgetown office during normal business hours, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. Written comments on the proposed lease will be accepted through June 20, 2003.
