## **Corps of Engineers initiates application process for waterfowl hunting at Proctor Lake**

FORT WORTH, TX -- The waterfowl hunting program on the developed wetland areas at Proctor Lake have become increasingly popular, creating a significant increase in hunter demand for limited hunting opportunities. To ensure that all hunters have an equal opportunity to participate in the program, the Corps of Engineers has implemented a new application process that permits hunters access into the Old Leon River, East Leon River, and Sabanna River wetlands. These wetland areas were constructed and are managed in cooperation with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, and Ducks Unlimited.

The Corps of Engineers at Proctor Lake is now accepting applications to hunt these areas during the 2003 - 2004 waterfowl season. Applications received by the application deadline of Oct. 10 will be entered into a random drawing. Successful applicants will receive their permit in the mail by Oct. 24.
