The purpose of these public meetings is to increase the awareness of Parker and Palo Pinto County residents of the potential for unexploded ordnance (UXO) on the property formerly known as Camp Wolters. Government officials will also inform residents about the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) investigation to be completed at this site. Presentations will address the camp's history and describe the upcoming ordnance investigation. Corps officials will be available for one-on-one interviews.
