U.S. Army Corps of Engineers waives Day Use, Camping Fees for active duty members on R&R from Iraq

FORT WORTH, Texas -- The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers announced today that it will waive day use and camping fees for active duty service personnel on temporary leave from duty in Iraq for the duration of United States operations there.

Corps lakes provide excellent opportunities to find renewal, solace and inspiration," said Maj. Gen. Carl A. Strock, Director of Civil Works. "Our intent is to recognize the selfless service of these men and women to our nation and the world."

Service members taking R&R will must show identification and leave orders for the waiver. The waiver will also apply to all family members accompanying the service member.

The Corps will waive camping fees on a walk-up and space-available basis as well as through the National Recreation Reservation Service call center at (877) 444-6777. Camping fees will not be waived for on-line reservations made through ReserveUSA.com.
