## **Corps of Engineers to hold Trinity River public meeting in Fort Worth**

FORT WORTH, TX – The Fort Worth District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will hold a public scoping meeting to gather information to use in preparation of a draft Environmental Impact Statement. The EIS will address potential multi-purpose projects for ecosystem restoration, flood damage reduction and recreation development within and along the Clear and West Forks of the Trinity River in Fort Worth.

The meeting will be held on Oct. 29, 2002, from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. at the YWCA Grand Ballroom, 512 West 4<sup>th</sup> Street, in downtown Fort Worth.
