## **Public invited to meeting about former bombing range investigation**

The public is invited to a meeting about the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' environmental investigation at the Former Five Points Outlying Field in southeast Arlington. The meeting will begin at 7 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 30, at the Mansfield Summit High School, 1071 W. Turner Warnell in Arlington. Sign-in for the meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m.

The 162-acre Five Points Outlying Field was used by the Navy in the 1940s as a practice bombing range. The Corps is conducting an investigation on the former range property, which is now occupied by the South Ridge Hills subdivision and a mobile home park, to determine if there is chemical contamination associated with the property's past military use.

At the meeting, the Corps will discuss its soil sampling and testing strategy and recap its work on the site in the past year.
