## **Corps of Engineers to hold public meeting about environmental restoration at Fort Wingate Depot Activity**

FORT WORTH, TX – The public is invited to attend the next Fort Wingate Depot Activity Community Meeting, hosted by Tooele Army Depot, on Wednesday, March 5. The meeting will begin at 7 p.m. and will be held at the Pueblo of Zuni Tribal Offices, 1203B State Highway 53 in Zuni, N.M.

The Fort Wingate Community Meetings act as a forum for the review of environmental restoration actions associated with Base Realignment and Closure activities. The intention of the meetings is to promote community awareness by inviting the public to comment throughout the restoration process.

The meeting will include results from the new TNT leaching bed wells, Tribal Trust process and status, and the status of parcels 6 and 22 Environmental Condition of Property.
