Corps plans Murrell and Rockledge Parks improvements at Grapevine Lake

FORT WORTH, Texas--The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced today the initiation of a park planning effort for facility improvements at Murrell and Rockledge Parks, located on the north side of Grapevine Lake. This is part of the Corps' long-term effort to plan and construct major improvements to the recreational facilities at Grapevine Lake.

At this time, the Corps is requesting comments and recommendations from the public concerning present-day facilities and future recreational uses at Murrell and Rockledge Parks. This is an opportunity for the public to make park facility preferences known to the Corps and to comment on operation and management issues.
