Corps of Engineers announces events to present perchlorate results.

Three events will be held next week to announce the completion of the Bosque and Leon Rivers Perchlorate Study, prepared by the Fort Worth District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Congressman Chet Edwards will hold a press conference on Monday, April 5, at 10 a.m. in McGregor, Texas, at 1111 South Johnson Drive, at a site adjacent to the McLennan Co-op.

A public meeting will be held on April 6, from 7 to 9 p.m., at A.J. Moore Academy Lecture Hall, 500 North University Parks Drive, in Waco.

A second public meeting will be held on April 7, from 7 to 9 p.m., in the McLane Room at the Temple Public Library, 100 West Adams Avenue, in Temple, Texas.

Agenda is the same for both public meetings.

The Corps has worked with the Brazos River Authority, Texas Tech University, state and federal regulators, the City of Waco, the Bell County Water Control and Improvement District, and Montgomery Watson Harza, a private contractor, to evaluate the potential human and environmental exposure to perchlorate contamination in the Bosque and Leon Watersheds of Central Texas. The study began in 2001 and is now complete. The final report is available at www.swf.usace.army.mil/links/ppmd/perchlorate/index.html.
