Corps of Engineers hosting two public meetings about perchlorate study.

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is hosting two public meetings about its Bosque and Leon Rivers Perchlorate Study.

The Corps has worked with the Brazos River Authority, Texas Tech University, state and federal regulators, the City of Waco, the Bell County Water Control and Improvement District, and Montgomery Watson Harza, a private contractor, to evaluate the potential human and environmental exposure to perchlorate contamination in the Bosque and Leon Rivers's area of Central Texas. The study began in 2001 and is now complete. The final report is available at www.swf.usace.army.mil/links/ppmd/perchlorate/index.html.
