The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Fort Worth District, hereby informs the public of the release of the draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment for the Wynnewood Park/Tribute Marina(hereafter Proposed Project), draft Finding of No Significant Impact. The purpose of Proposed Project is to provide additional recreational facilities and more efficient access to Lewisville Lake. The additional facilities entail constructing a marina with up to 801 wet boat slips, a 4,800 square foot store, deli, fuel service facility, a 5,000 square foot restaurant, a paved parking lot with a capacity for 360 vehicles and 113 golf carts, grass parking with 176 spaces available, a 3,107 square foot multipurpose concrete pad, a 36,000 square foot multipurpose lawn, and lawn game areas.
