### ***Ray Roberts Lake Master Plan Revision***

*Comments Due By June 20, 2022*

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has drafted a revision to the Ray Roberts Lake Master Plan in accordance with current laws and regulations, public stakeholder comments, and expert advice. The master plan revision will guide the land and recreational management of the federally owned property that make up the lake and its shoreline for the next 25 years. Management activities include protecting natural and cultural resources, providing public land and water recreation, protecting the public, and ensuring reservoir and dam operations.
