FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
FOR THE PROPOSED EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENTS AT
DALLAS-FORT WORTH NATIONAL CEMETERY
DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS

The public is hereby notified of the availability of the Final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) prepared by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Fort Worth District, on behalf of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). The Final EA and FONSI address the proposed construction and operation of an additional columbarium, committal service shelter, cortege lane, and 27-acre burial expansion site at the Dallas-Fort Worth National Cemetery, Dallas County, Texas. Additionally, dredging and maintenance activities will occur in and around Veterans Lake, located within the cemetery. The Final EA and FONSI will be available to the public at the Dallas-Fort Worth National Cemetery, 2000 Mountain Creek Parkway, Dallas, TX 75211, and the Department of Veterans Affairs, National Cemetery Administration, Design and Construction Services, 425 I Street, NW, Washington, DC 20001.
