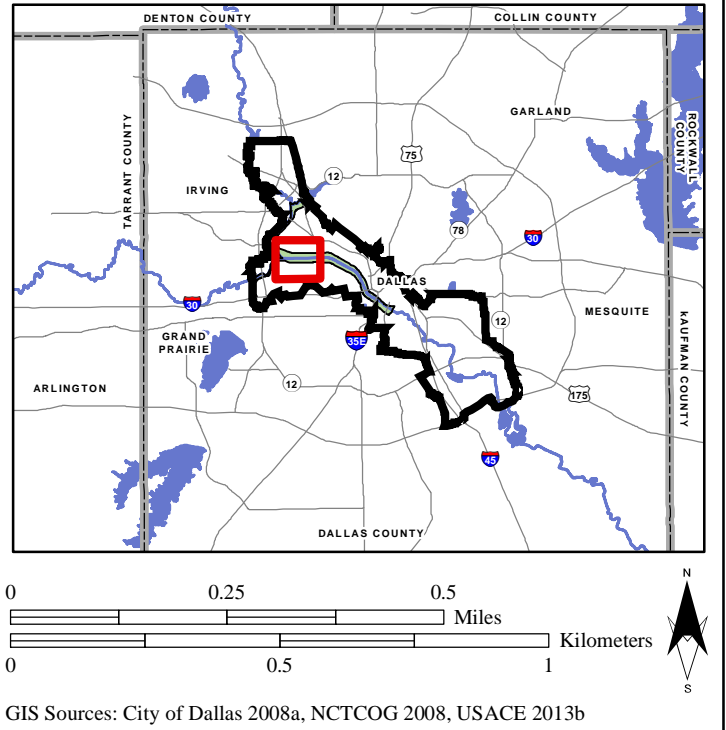

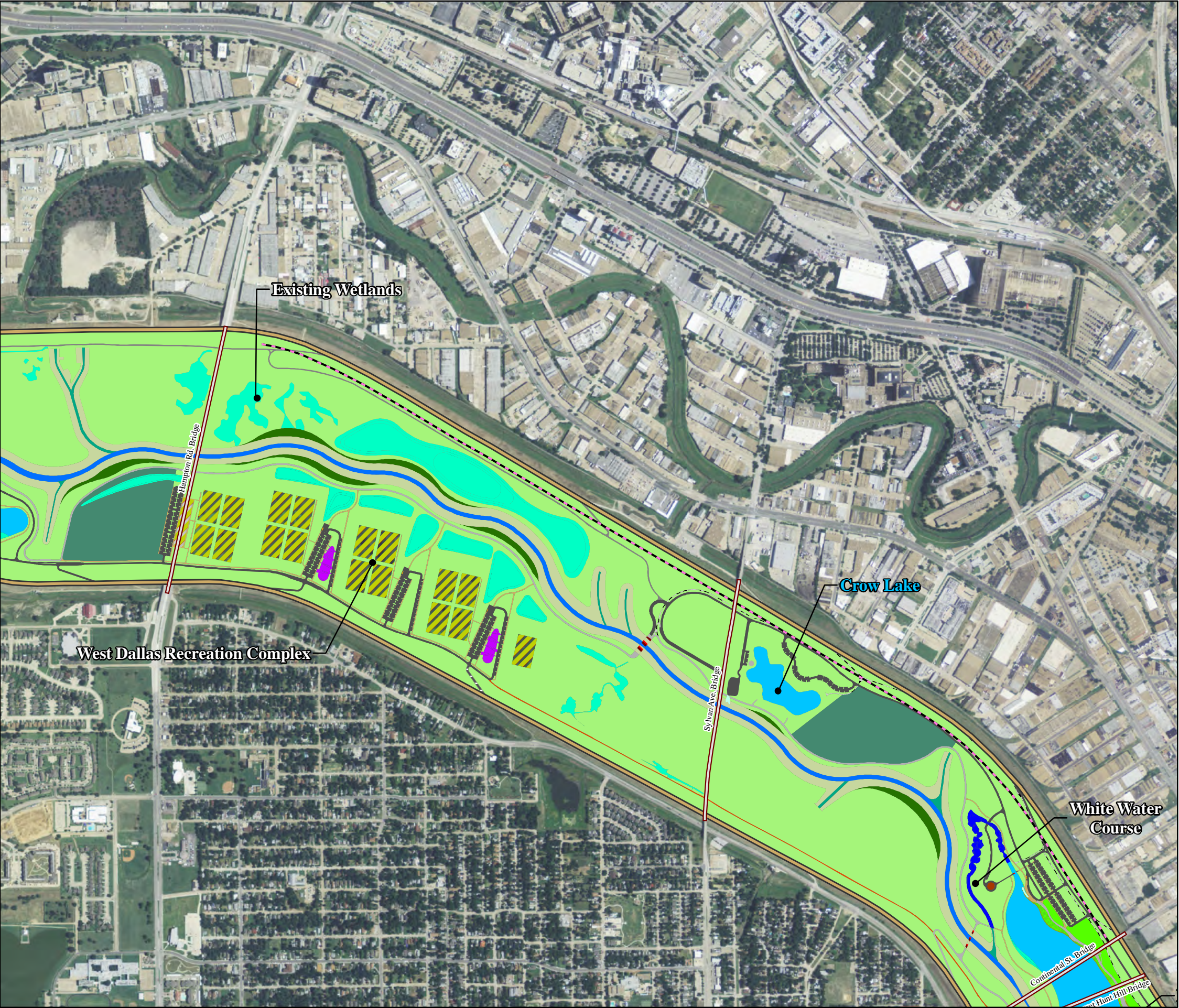

Middle Segment



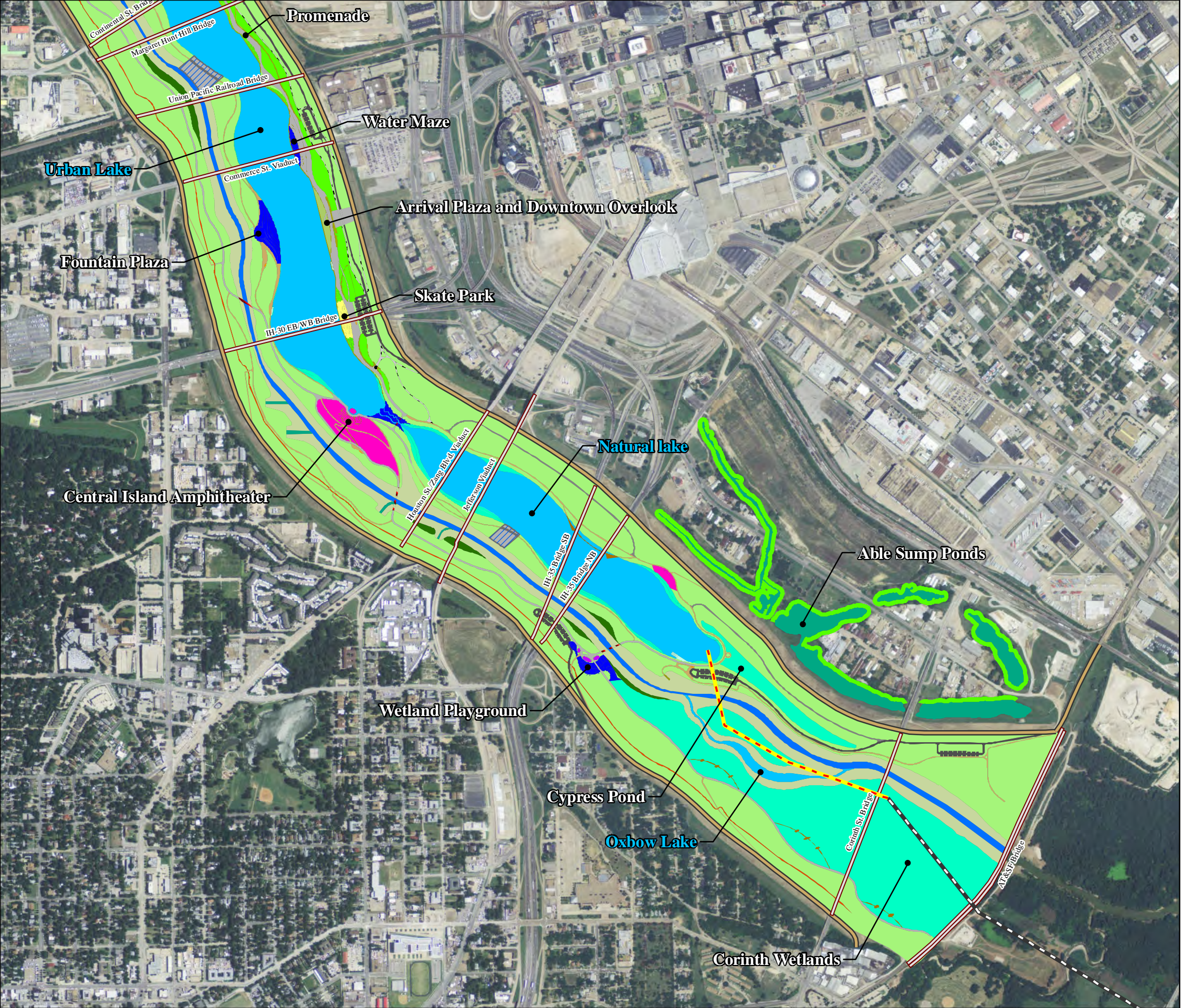
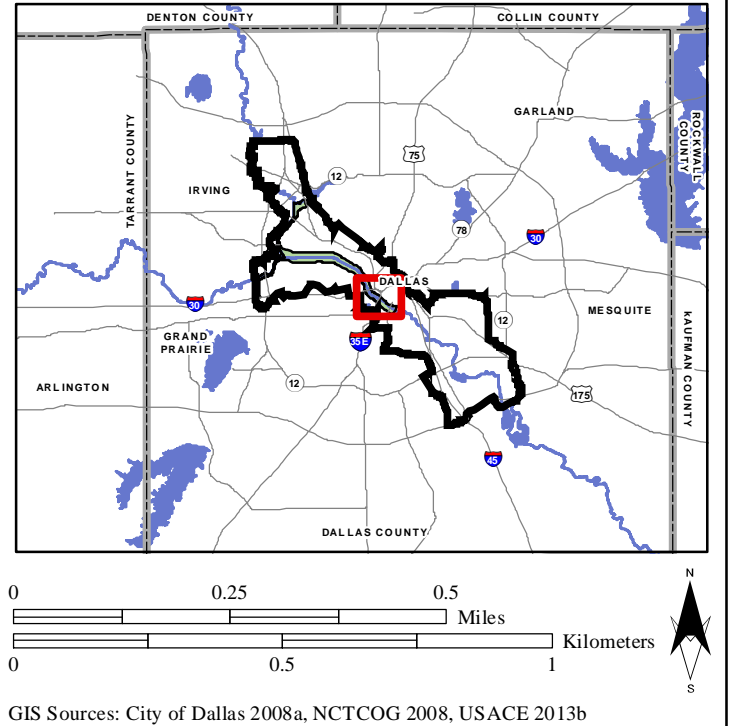

Southern Segment



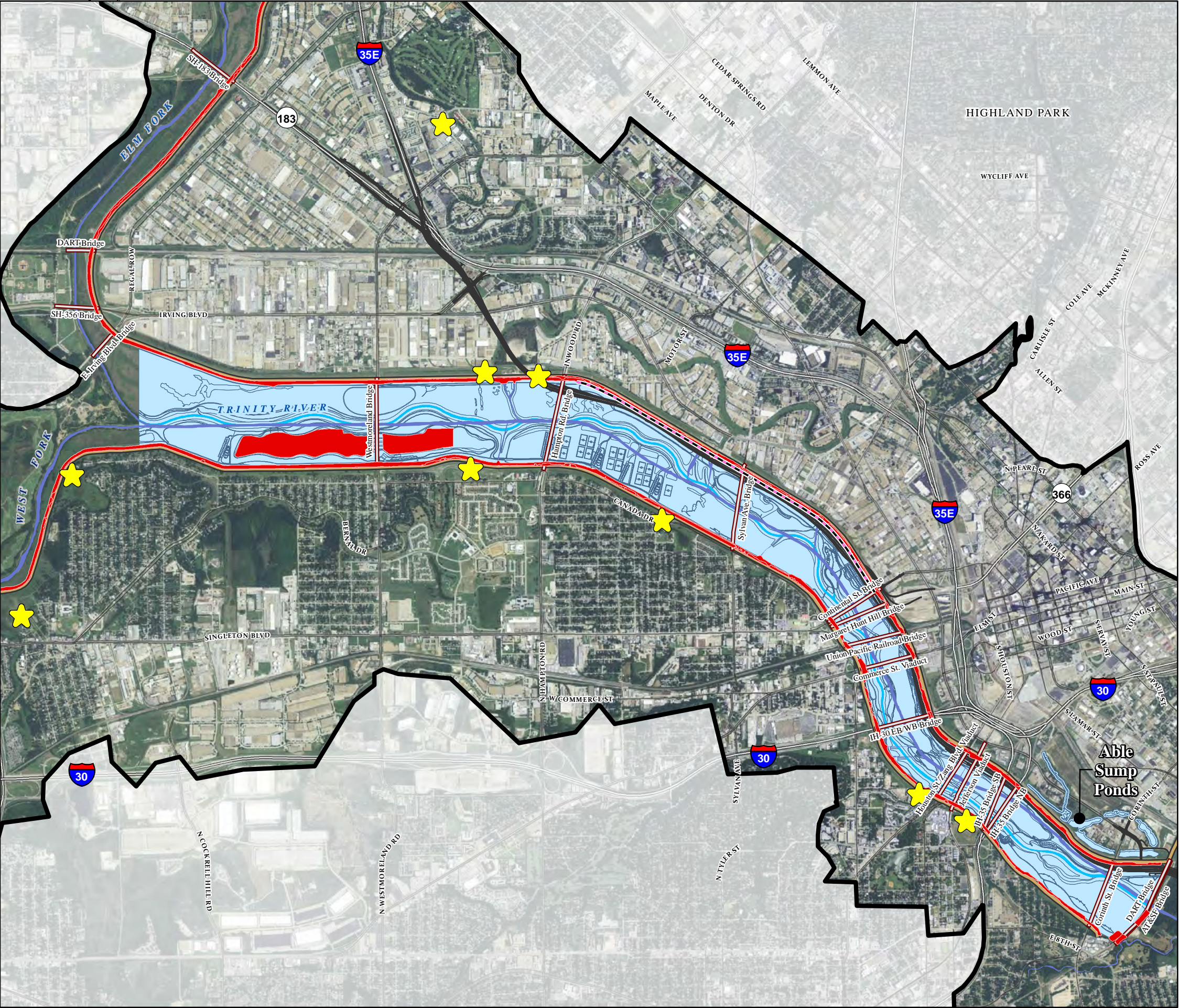

Overview of Alternative 2

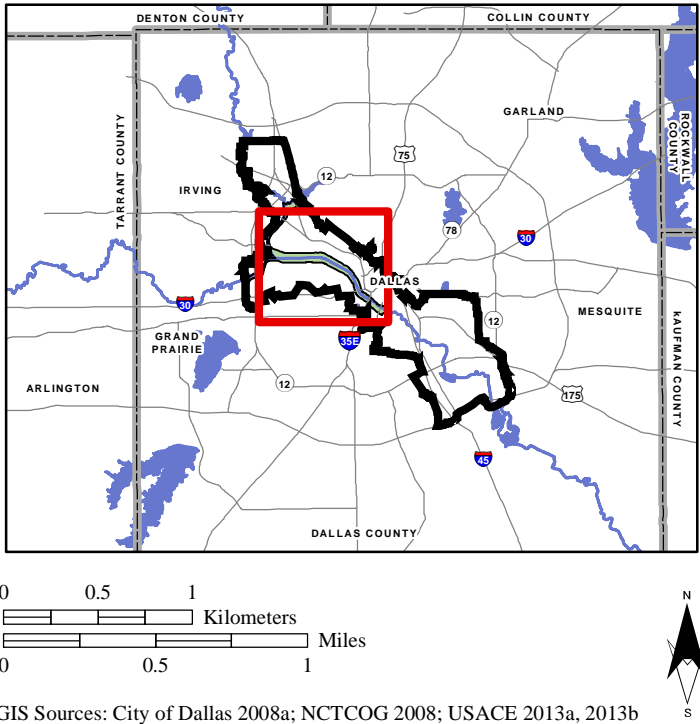
