Withdrawal of Notice of Intent, Johnson Creek

Date issued: August 5, 2019

Withdrawal of Intent to Prepare a Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Potential Multipurpose Projects for Ecosystem Restoration, Flood Risk Management, and Recreation Development Within and Along Johnson Creek, Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas

PURPOSE: The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Fort Worth District, is issuing this public notice to advise federal, state, and local governmental agencies and the public that the USACE is withdrawing its Notice of Intent (NOI) to prepare a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Potential Multipurpose Projects for Ecosystem Restoration, Flood Risk Management, and Recreation Development Within and Along Johnson Creek, in Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas.

SUMMARY: The original NOI was published in the Federal Register on July 18, 2008. A public scoping meeting for the EIS was held on July 31, 2008 at the Bob Duncan Center, located within Vandergriff Park, 2800 South Center Street, Arlington, Texas, 76014. The City of Arlington, the non-federal sponsor, requested that all work associated with the EIS be terminated and that they no longer wish to pursue the Johnson Creek: A Vision of Conservation Plan. The City of Arlington notified the USACE of the request to terminate the feasibility study and EIS on January 22, 2019. The USACE published the Withdrawal of the NOI in the Federal Register on August 2, 2019.

REMAINING USACE PROJECT: A USACE federally authorized Civil Works project was constructed along Johnson Creek from approximately 2001-2006. The authorized project purposes of this Johnson Creek Project are Flood Risk Management, Ecosystem Restoration, and Recreation. This Johnson Creek Project is located approximately from Interstate Highway 20 downstream to Texas Highway 360 in Arlington, Texas. The City of Arlington is the non-federal sponsor, with ongoing responsibilities for operation and maintenance.
